Greetings from Switzerland for the last time – we will be returning to our usual prayer letters every few months once we get home again. This time next week we should be finishing our last classes, packing the car for our trip back home and getting ready for our graduation service on Friday 17th at 6.30pm. It is hard to believe that eleven weeks of our course are now completed. It has gone so quick.



Since our last update we have been studying the book of Galatians, how to build a ministry, time management and prayer support. A great deal of the content covered is of a practical nature and will be very useful over the coming months and years. Next week we will be studying about youth challenge and leadership. As usual we have had a good number of

written assignments, practicals and written tests. It has been good to be kept busy as it helps the time go quicker – less time to think of home and family. Thank God for how He has helped both us and the girls over the past two weeks of being separated. We speak to them most evening over Skype which allows us to see them as well as hear them – this has really helped.



Last weekend all the students went on a trip to Interlaken and Grindlewald about two hours away. Paddy especially loved this as Grindlewald is in the middle of the ‘real’ alps at the base of the Eiger Mountain. Stunning scenery – we truly have an amazing God when we stand in awe and wonder at the beauty of His creation. We spent a few hours there and then went on to see some waterfalls where you walk up alongside them through a network of tunnels cut out through the rockface – amazing!!
