The CMLC Course

12 weeks, 330 classes and numerous assignments, practicals and exams later we



have completed the Children's Ministry Leadership Course. We have studied a wide range of topics including; the Biblical basis for evangelising children, Doctrine, how to teach a Bible lesson, teacher training, youth challenge work, Galatians & Ephesians, organising a local work and many more. Each day we had classes from 8:30am to 1:15pm as well as 3-4 hours study each afternoon and evening. We have learned much over the 12 weeks and look forward to putting it into practice in the coming days. There was a student prayer time each day and we took our turn at leading this with a short devotional thought.

Camp Week

It was so good to have the opportunity to put some of what we had learned into practice during the week of camp in early August. 34 children came from an American Army Base in Germany for the week. They were taught lessons from the life of Joseph and heard the missionary story about the life of Amy Carmichael. The children listened well and it was good to have the opportunity to talk to some of them as individuals about spiritual matters. Outings to a local swimming pool, tropical gardens and a high ropes course were enjoyed by all – leaders included.
